With its competition leadership located in both Zurich and Geneva, **Lenz & Staehelin** has a major presence in the Swiss bar. Marcel Meinhardt fronts the team in Zurich and Benoît Merkt heads the Geneva practice. Both are *Who's Who* nominees. In total, the team comprises three partners and 10 associates, including Zurich-based senior associate Astrid Waser, who specialises in antitrust litigation. Meinhardt says the team

has “grown significantly” since 2002, when he was the sole competition partner, and he envisages it will continue to do so.

The firm is present on some of the most high-profile cases in the country. It was acting for Sunrise, the Swiss mobile arm of Denmark's TDC, in the phase II merger with France Telecom's Orange. Lenz & Staehelin represents the country's largest construction company, Implenia, following dawn raids

last July. It is also advising MasterCard on interchange fees, and is acting in several major investigations and proceedings in the consumer goods, perfume, pharmaceuticals and ticketing markets. Other long-standing competition clients include Colgate-Palmolive, Mars, Shell, SAP and Deutsche Bahn.
